DODE BUILDING CLOSED INDEFINITELY DUE TO NO HVAC

The Navajo Education Center, which houses the Department of Diné Education and its programs, was issued an Order of Closure January 22 due to the lack of a working HVAC system. This left the building too cold for workers to perform their duties as designated by Navajo Occupational Safety & Health Administration staff.

Staff are not permitted onsite until NOSHA staff deem it safe for occupants to enter. Programs have relocated staff to offices in and around Window Rock.
